

Ryanair Wins Belgian Court Case against Consumer Association

Ryanair today (15 Mar) confirmed that last week's Belgian court decision in Namur was a great victory for Belgian consumers/ visitors as it proves that the Test Achats' claims about Ryanair's low fares were false and untrue. The Belgian court rightly dismissed most of the Test Achats' allegations, including their ridiculous suggestion that the www.ryanair.com website be closed down. This court ruling now allows Ryanair to continue to offer Belgian consumers/ visitors the lowest fares and the best punctuality of flights in Belgium. The Namur court judgment made a few minor recommendations about Ryanair's website and we will appeal or implement these in due course. This year Ryanair will carry over 4 million passengers to/from Brussels Charleroi airport, saving Belgian consumers/ visitors over €660 million and supporting more than 4,000 local jobs.
