LAUDA ADDS 4 AIRCRAFT TO VIENNA BASE FOR S2020 (16 A/C) 17 NEW SUMMER 2020 ROUTES & 9M CUSTOMERS P.A.

Lauda, Austria's No. 1 low fares airline, today (26 Sept) announced it will base an additional 4 aircraft (16 in total) at its Vienna base, as part of its biggest ever Summer 2020 schedule. In summer 2020, Vienna consumers/visitors will enjoy 17 new routes (67 routes in total) to/from Vienna at much lower fares than Austrian, Eurowings, or Lufthansa. Lauda today releases its Summer 2020 schedule, and these 17 new summer 2020 routes go on sale today.

With 17 new S20 routes in Vienna, including exciting connections to Milan, Brindisi, Palermo and Greece, Lauda's Summer 2020 schedule in Vienna, Germany and Spain will help deliver over 9m customers across Lauda's network in its 3rd year of operation, creating over 500 new jobs in Lauda.

The Lauda fleet in Vienna, which this winter is 12 aircraft (all Airbus A320s), will grow to 16 aircraft with the addition of 4 B737 aircraft for summer 2020. Lauda's fleet of A320s will increase from 22 to over 33 aircraft in summer 2020, but most of these additional aircraft will be allocated to Lauda's growing bases in Germany and in Palma (Spain) where the Lauda fleet will double from 4 to 10 aircraft for summer 2020.

Lauda's summer 2020 schedule in Vienna will deliver:

- 16 aircraft, double the 8 aircraft of summer 2019
- 17 new routes (67 in total)
- Full year traffic of 9m customers
- 500 new jobs

To celebrate its largest ever summer schedule, Lauda has launched a seat sale with fares on its Vienna routes available from just €9.99 for travel in Oct and Nov which must be booked by midnight Friday (27 Sept), available on the Laudamotion.com website.





In Vienna, Lauda's CEO Andreas Gruber said:

"We are excited to add 4 new aircraft in Vienna next Summer, as part of our largest ever summer schedule. By doubling our Vienna based fleet from 8 aircraft in summer 2019 to 16 aircraft in summer 2020, we can offer our Viennese consumers/visitors 67 routes at fares that are in many cases less than half the prices charged by Austrian, Eurowings, and Lufthansa. These new aircraft and new routes will clearly establish Lauda as the No. 2 airline in Austria, with over 9m passengers p.a. Our summer 2020 schedule will see the Lauda fleet grow to 33 aircraft at 4 bases in Vienna, Stuttgart, Dusseldorf and Palma, and will see Lauda grow our annual traffic from 6.5m customers in 2019 to over 9m passengers in 2020."
