UPDATE MON 25 MAY – LIMITED SCHEDULE EXTENDED TO SAT 20 JUN

As most EU countries have imposed flight bans or other restrictions, over 99% of Ryanair's aircraft are grounded until 1 July, when we plan to return to 40% of normal flight schedules subject to these Govt restrictions being lifted.

In the meantime, we are working with EU Governments to try to keep some minimum flight links open for emergency reasons, even though the passenger loads on these flights is very low. We are extending this limited schedule to Sat 20 June. Ryanair is operating these flights daily or weekly:
